Minutes of the last meeting

The minutes of the last meeting on 26 August 2014 were accepted and signed by the Chairman.

The Residents' Questionnaire Report.

The Chairman thanked Data Orchard for their work on the questionnaire and their advice which was much appreciated. A couple of problems were pointed out to Bill Bloxome. The chart for Q 33 appears on pages 21 and 22. On page 22 it was probably printed instead of a chart for Q34. The chart for Q28 has incorrect labelling together with some small numerical errors.

The Chairman asked if any more analysis was required of the first five or six questions. Any comments or questions should be sent to The Chairman before the next meeting.

The Development Plan.

It was decided that we would form three groups to walk round the three main villages and check out possible sites for housing development. The groups would be:

Adforton: Clive Gurney, Chris Jack, Glyn Williams and Tony Swainson.

Lingen: Phil Barnett, Robert Nisbet, Harley Thomas, John Walker, Moira Williamson.

Brampton Bryan: Simon Whiteman would liaise with Paul Segrott the Harley Estate Land Agent.

Maps will be provided by Herefordshire Council on which sites can be marked. Possible sites need to be checked out within the next three weeks to gather enough information to present at public meetings and/or exhibitions in the three villages in about four weeks' time.

An outline for a draft plan produced by Bill has been circulated to the Steering Group. But they had not had sufficient time to study it before the meeting. It was agreed that we need Bill Bloxome's help in putting the plan together. His fees would be about £40 per hour. Whilst Samantha Banks of Herefordshire Council is willing to advise she has very limited time at the moment.

As the grant funding is to be spent by the end of December, invoices must have been received by then for payment in early January.
