Joint Annual Meeting – Brampton Bryan, Buckton & Coxall
Brampton Bryan Parish Hall, Tuesday 13 May 2014, 7:30pm

Present: Parish Councillors Mrs M Brown (Chair) and Mr R Ruell.
Also present: 1 resident from Brampton Bryan parish, and 2 from Buckton & Coxall.

1. **Apologies** – Cllr Susan Harley
2. **Minutes of the last meeting** were read out and signed as correct.
3. **P3** – Mr Oliver (BGPC's Footpath Officer) reported that after 3 months of bad weather the full allowance had been spent on trimming, lopping, bridges, metal kissing gates, stile repairs and finger posts. Balfour Beatty advised the P3 £50/km still in place. Rachel Dixon is our first contact.
4. **Litter** – the problem with roadside litter was discussed. It was explained that it is within the Lengthsman's remit to pick up litter. A suggestion was made that if the Lengthsman does not have time, perhaps someone else could be paid to do the job.
5. **Bridges** – a question was asked about the weight limit on the bridge between Walford and Buckton asking, purely as a matter of interest, how agricultural vehicles cope with the restriction.
6. **Flooding** – the problem of flooding between Buckton and Walford was raised. Does the lengthsman do regular inspections to check which ditches need to be cleared?
7. **Erosion** – the erosion of the lane between Brampton Bryan and Buckton had been reported to Herefordshire Council, but no reply had been received. This is on the Agenda for the Annual Meeting of the Parish council on Tuesday 20 May 2014.
8. **Weymore Lane** – A resident from Adleymoor had reported several potholes in Weymore Lane. The resident subsequently reported these had been patched.
