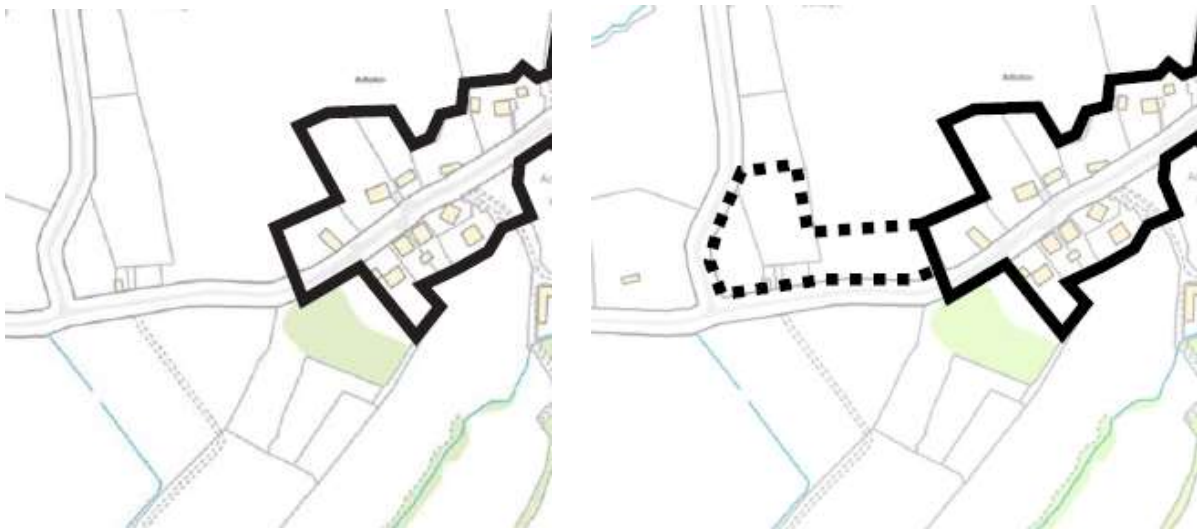


FURTHER CONSULTATION ON BORDER GROUP NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN (Adforton)

The Local Steering Group has carefully considered residents' comments on the draft plan - for which thanks. Changes to the plan are being proposed to make the plan more likely to protect Adforton's special character, and more likely to pass formal examination (by an independent official examiner). It is proposed that we extend the settlement boundary for the village along Letton lane on its north side, allowing room for two houses. The plans below show the current boundary and proposed extension. Overall the proposed would add (net) one new house, because the allocation to another site has gone down. We hope this change will reduce the risk of development outside the settlement boundary, or the risk that an examiner will remove the settlement boundary entirely. The group is also proposing new design guidelines which will ensure development is high quality and fits the village's character, and if you have suggestions we would very much like to hear them.
